

MALLORCA TOUR - SPAIN

Visit Majorca, Europe's most popular cycling island. The start is located to the north of Algaida on the western side of the island. The picturesque route takes you on quiet roads through a gently rolling landscape. You cycle through small villages passing by Petra, Sa Vall and the rather busier towns of Manacor and Lluçmajor. The many small hills on the way to Algaida makes this a demanding route. After the five kilometre climb of the Cura you finish at the Monastery of Randa

Course information

An incredibly scenic route along quiet roads on Europe's most popular training camp destination. Starting just north of Algaida on the western side of the island you shall ride westwards over easy undulating terrain towards Petra & then onwards via Sa Vall to Majorca's second major town Manacor. A few miles after Manacor you are seamlessly transferred to the second part of the ride. This places you back in the dryer eastern side of the island & on a very narrow tranquil cycle route heading north towards the town of Lluçmajor. After passing this busy town you take the road to Algaida which is more demanding with its constant rolling hills. The sting in the tail that is waiting for you is the 5km climb to the Monastery of Randa ('Cura'). This climb is visible to all that come to Majorca as its volcano like flat top & golf ball radars are clearly visible to the east of Palma airport. The ride ends at the entrance to the Monastery & perhaps an imaginary cool drink on the monastery terrace overlooking Palma?
